Canadian Eventing

What is Eventing?

The sport of Eventing is best described as an equine triathlon. It began as a military exercise and competition for cavalry horses and officers to test their endurance, agility, and ability to get quickly between two points in the countryside. Today, in the modern equivalent, the sport of eventing encompasses three separate tests: dressage, cross-country, and show jumping. Each is scored individually but added together for the final results, and the winner of the competition is the competitor with the least number of penalty points gained over the three phases. The team winner is the team with the lowest aggregate number of penalties among team members.

What is Canadian Eventing?

Canadian Eventing is a committee of Equine Canada responsible for the sport of Eventing in Canada, from the domestic development to the international elite level. Canadian Eventing is governed by a committee comprised of 12 members, including two rider representatives. All activities of Canadian Eventing are administered by this committee via 5 sub-committees with the support of technical manager Fleur Tipton, who is based at the Equine Canada offices in Ottawa.

Guiding Principals of Canadian Eventing Committee are:

- To develop an integrated sport system across Canada which provides a pathway for riders to develop according to the principles of the LTAD.
- To develop riders within the framework of the LTAD equestrian model to that provides opportunity from "grass roots" to podium and promotes self expression and individuality in pursuit of individual excellence.
- To develop coaches with the ability to meet the needs of riders within the framework of the LTAD equestrian model.
- To have sufficient, well educated, knowledgeable officials for every level of competition in Canada.
- To be executed through responsible fiscal management through governance.

Formed in 1998, the **Elite Riders Association (ERA)** is an association dedicated to representing and promoting the views and interests of event riders in Canada. The ERA membership is comprised of all high performance Eventing athletes, including short-listed and long-listed riders.

As the voice of the Canadian Eventing National Team's listed riders, ERA maintains athlete representatives on the Equine Canada CE High Performance Committee and the Canadian Eventing Committee, the national governing body for the sport of Eventing in Canada. The CE High Performance Committee oversees all high performance activities, including planning and administering the National Team Program, hiring of the Technical Advisor, development of selection criteria and the selection process, and hiring of competition sports science support personnel. The ERA membership is also responsible for voting on the appointment of two of the Team selectors. Communication within ERA keeps riders updated with regards to policy-making and news bulletins of Canadian Eventing, Equine Canada, and the FEI. Currently, the ERA representatives on the Canadian Eventing High Performance Committee are Kyle Carter (2008-2009) and Samantha Taylor (2008-2009).

Hawley Bennett grew up on a hobby farm and was involved with the 4-H Horse Club and the Grove and Langley Pony Club. With Livingstone, a thoroughbred gelding bred by her neighbour and purchased as a four-year-old, Hawley formed a truly incredible partnership. Following a fourth place finish at the 1998 North American Young Riders' Championship, Hawley, then 21, was named to the Canadian Eventing Team Long List.

In 2002, Hawley and Livingstone finished 14th at the CCI*** Fair Hill International and, the following year, enjoyed a clear cross-country performance at the prestigious CCI**** Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event. In the fall of 2003, they were members of the Silver Medal Team at the 2003 Pan American Eventing Championships and Hawley's Olympic dream became a reality when she and Livingstone represented the Canadian Equestrian Team in Athens, Greece. In 2005, the fairy tale continued when Hawley and Livingstone traveled to Sweden

where they placed 15th in the World Cup Final. In 2007, the pair accomplished yet another goal by successfully completing CCI**** Badminton in England.

Hawley currently trains in Temecula, California.

With Tyson, Diana competed at the 1999 North American Young Riders' Championship and was the top-placed Canadian, finishing eighth individually and leading the team to a fourth place finish. In 2002, the pair again placed eighth at the North American Young Riders' Championship and went on to win the Canadian Open Championship in 2002.

In 2005 and 2006, Diana was named to the Canadian Eventing Team Talent Squad, a means of identifying future members of the Canadian Team, with Sagacious King. The appointment was well-deserved as Diana rode her homebred gelding

Manny to 12th place in the 2007 Red Hills Horse Trials followed by a 14th place finish in the CCI** division of the Florida International Three Day Event in Ocala, FL. The pair ended the season in 23rd position at the CCI*** Fair Hill Three Day Event in Maryland to earn Short-Listed status with the Canadian Eventing Team.

A graduate of Trent University, Diana teaches and trains at her family's Donogue Farm.

Riding since he can remember, Kyle grew up on his parents' thoroughbred racing farm. Interested in show jumping as a teenager, Kyle trained with Albert Kley at the famed Spruce Meadows facility. At 18, he turned his focus to eventing and spent a year training in England with 2004 Olympic Gold Medalist Leslie Law.

After returning to Canada, Kyle started up his own business of buying and selling horses off the Calgary racetrack, and eventually moved his business to Kentucky where he stayed for three years. Having represented Canada at the 1999 Pan American Games in Winnipeg riding Scotia Goldrush, Kyle was the highest-placed Canadian at the 2007 Pan American Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, leading his country to the Team Silver Medal.

Now based in Citra, Florida, Kyle and his wife, Jennifer, an advanced-level competitor, run their own training and breeding facility. In addition to enjoying success with a large string of horses, Kyle is also a Level III coach and has coached many members of both the Canadian and American long lists. Kyle enjoys sailing, skiing, running and windsurfing as well as spending time with his daughter, Riley, born in December of 2006.

Sandra Donnelly began riding almost as soon as she could walk. Active in the Canadian Pony Club, she achieved her 'A' Level and went on to compete in show jumping, earning the 1991 Alberta Show Jumping Association's Modified Jumper Championship title.

In 1990, Sandra qualified two horses for the North American Young Riders' Championship, one each in show jumping and eventing. In 2004, she placed 25th at the CIC*** Fair Hill International riding Willow, a mare she purchased as a weanling at a PMU auction, to earn Long List status. In 2005, she was again Long Listed after enjoying top finishes with Buenos Aires and Whiz Kid at the CCI** Foxhall Cup Three Day Event. Currently, Sandra is Short Listed based on her finish in the 2006 CCI*** Fair Hill Three Day Event riding Buenos Aires, a horse she bred herself. In 2007, Sandra and Buenos Aires were members of Canada's Silver Medal Team at the Pan

American Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, also placing sixth individually.

Sandra operates Alborak Stable where she provides lessons and training and also breeds sport horses specifically for eventing and jumping. A graduate of the University of Calgary, Sandra holds her bachelor of science in Mechanical Engineering. Active in the Canadian Warmblood Breeders Association of Alberta and the Alberta Horse Trials Association, Sandra also enjoys women's hockey.

With Snappy, sired by Queen's Plate winner Fiddle Dancer Boy, Lesley completed both the 2002 and 2003 editions of the CCI*** Fox Hall Cup and also the 2003 CCI*** Fair Hill International before the mare was sold.

With Timber Spirit, an English thoroughbred with impressive bloodlines, Lesley completed the CCI*** Fox Hall Cup two years in a row, the 2003 CIC*** World Cup Qualifier at Over the Walls Horse Trials and, in 2004, enjoyed top ten finishes at the CIC** Dreamcrest Horse Trials and the CIC** Red Hills Horse Trials. In 2005, they added a 20th place finish at CCI**** Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event to their impressive list of accomplishments and, the following year, completed Rolex's cross-country phase with no jumping penalties. In 2008, Lesley and Timber Spirit finished 11th at the CIC*** Red Hills Horse Trials and 13th at the CCI*** Jersey Fresh Three Day Event to

earn Olympic gualification.

Lesley operates Law Eventing with her husband, 2004 Olympic Champion Leslie Law. She holds an honours degree in International Relations and Philosophy and a Masters degree in Human Rights from York University. In her free time, she enjoys reading, writing and travel.

In 2007, Selena was Long Listed based on her finish at the 2006 CCI** Virginia Three Day Event riding Colombo. Colombo is owned by Elaine and Michael Davies and Selena is the resident trainer at their facility, Hawkridge Farm, in Elgin, Ontario.

Having spent time in England in 2007 training with Pamela Hutton, Selena opened the 2008 season by placing fifth

with Colombo in the CIC*** division of the Red Hills Horse Trials in Florida. In preparation for her own four-star debut, Selena has attended the CCI**** Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event and England's CCI**** Badminton Three Day Event. 



International Technical Advisor

The Canadian Eventing Team is pleased to be working with David O'Connor as its International Technical Advisor. Competing for the United States Equestrian Team, David earned three Olympic, two World Championships and two Pan American Games medals. He won the Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event three times and is a five-time winner of the Fair Hill International Three Day Event. In 1997, he became only the second American to win the renowned Badminton Three Day Event.

The pinnacle of David's eventing career was reached at the 2000 Olympic Games in Sydney, Australia, when he captured the Individual Gold Medal riding Custom Made, and also secured the Team Bronze Medal riding Giltedge. In 2004, David officially retired from international competition to focus on the training of riders and horses. Together with his wife and Olympic medallist teammate, Karen O'Connor, they operate training facilities at their home base in Virginia as well as Florida.

David is the President of the United States Equestrian Federation and is also a member of the FEI Eventing Committee. In addition, David is the cross-country course designer for several venues including the new Ocala Horse Park in Florida and the North American Young Riders' Championship in Virginia.

Olympic Competition - How it works!

At the 2008 Olympic Games, the team competition consists of a minimum of three and a maximum of five competitors with the best three scores to count for the team classification. Following the first round of show jumping, which determines the team medal winners, the top 25 competitors will jump a second round to determine the individual medalists.


