Canadian Eventing

What is Eventing?

The sport of Eventing is best described as an equine triathlon. It began as a military exercise and competition for cavalry horses and officers to test their endurance, agility, and ability to get quickly between two points in the countryside. Today, in the modern equivalent, the sport of eventing encompasses three separate tests: dressage, cross-country, and show jumping. Each is scored individually but added together for the final results, and the winner of the competition is the competitor with the least number of penalty points gained over the three phases. The team winner is the team with the lowest aggregate number of penalties among team members.

What is Canadian Eventing?

Canadian Eventing is a committee of Equine Canada responsible for the sport of Eventing in Canada, from the domestic development to the international elite level. Canadian Eventing is governed by a committee comprised of 12 members, including two rider representatives. All activities of Canadian Eventing are administered by this committee via 5 sub-committees with the support of technical manager Fleur Tipton, who is based at the Equine Canada offices in Ottawa.

Core Objectives

Through its Strategic Plan, the Canadian Eventing Committee is committed to programs to achieve the following Goals:

1. A higher standard of performance excellence demonstrated by Canadian athletes and Canadian teams at national and international competitions and championships.
2. A team podium performance at the 2012 Olympic Games.
3. A broad and diverse foundation of athletes that enjoy and compete safely, competently and equitably

at world class standard national and international sanctioned eventing competitions, in all provinces across Canada.

4. A clear development pathway for competitive athletes supported by a system of trained and certified Eventing Coaches and Officials who are committed to excellence through ongoing professional development.
5. A vibrant and viable economic and business model which supports the organization.

Canadian Eventing has a number of important and exciting national programs to support grass-roots, developing, high performance and elite athletes. These programs include:

- Canadian Eventing Athlete Development Scholarship Program
- National course review and standardization for competitions
- Provincial Domestic Athlete and Course Development Support Program
- Sports Science Support Program
- National Team Training Program
- Eventing NCCP Coaching Certification Program

Formed in 1998, the **Elite Riders Association (ERA)** is an association dedicated to representing and promoting the views and interests of event riders in Canada. The ERA membership is comprised of all high performance Eventing athletes, including short-listed and long-listed riders.

As the voice of the Canadian Eventing National Team's listed riders, ERA maintains athlete representatives on the Equine Canada CE High Performance Committee and the Canadian Eventing Committee, the national governing body for the sport of Eventing in Canada. The CE High Performance Committee oversees all high performance activities, including planning and administering the National Team Program, hiring of the Technical Advisor, development of selection criteria and the selection process, and hiring of competition sports science support personnel. The ERA membership is also responsible for voting on the appointment of two of the Team selectors. Communication within ERA keeps riders updated with regards to policy-making and news bulletins of Canadian Eventing, Equine Canada, and the FEI. Currently, the ERA representatives on the Canadian Eventing High Performance Committee are Jennifer Holling (2006-2007) and Kelli McMullen-Temple (2007-2008).

Riding since he can remember, Kyle grew up on his parents' thoroughbred racing farm. Interested in show jumping as a teenager, Kyle trained with Albert Kley at the famed Spruce Meadows facility. At 18, he turned his focus to eventing and spent a year training in England with 2004 Olympic Gold Medalist Leslie Law.

After returning to Canada, Kyle started up his own business of buying and selling horses off the Calgary racetrack, and eventually moved his business to Kentucky where he stayed for three years. He then moved to Ontario where he competed for Hawkridge Farm and enjoyed a second place finish at the 1999 CCI*** Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event on Scotia Goldrush. The pair also represented Canada at the 1999 Pan American Games in Winnipeg.

Now based in Citra, Florida, Kyle and his wife, Jennifer, an advanced-level competitor, run their own training and breeding facility. In addition to enjoying success with a large string of horses, Kyle is also a Level 3 coach and has coached many members of both the Canadian and American long lists. Kyle enjoys sailing, skiing, running and windsurfing as well as spending time with his new daughter, Riley, born in December of 2006.

He competed in his first horse trials event at the age of 14 and, since then, has steadily climbed up the Eventing ranks. In both 2003 and 2005, Noel was awarded a Canadian Eventing Rider Development Scholarship.

It is with Jack of Hearts that Noel has enjoyed his most success to date. A Canadian Sport Horse gelding bred by Sue Ockendon, Jack of Hearts was donated to Equine Canada by Alan Sandler and Noel was selected as his rider. Together, they earned a Team Gold Medal in the CCIJ* division at the 2005 North American Young Riders' Championship in Virginia and also placed seventh individually. In 2006, their result at the inaugural CCI** Florida International Three Day Event in Ocala earned them a place on the Canadian Eventing Team Long List.

Noel is currently in his second year of Kinesiology studies at the University of Calgary and is interested in human and equine biomechanics. Noel volunteers his time to teach at the Westbrook Pony Club in his hometown of Cochrane, and also enjoys hiking and camping in the nearby Rocky Mountains.

Jessica DiGenova began riding at the age of five in a western saddle and, three years later, switched to english after attending a summer riding camp. Having tried eventing on her mom's horse, Jessica purchased Upolu from her coach, Leahona Rowland, and was competing at preliminary level by the end of the season.

In 2005, Jessica and Upolu were members of the Ontario Team that won the CCIJ* division of the North American Young Riders' Championship, also placing first individually. Jessica's success continued in 2006 when, having spent the winter in Ocala, Florida, training with U.S. Olympian Darren Chiacchia, she won the inaugural CCI** Florida International Three Day Event in April. She and Upolu then claimed Individual and Team Bronze Medals in the CCI** division of the North American Young Riders' Championship. As a result, she was awarded a \$1,000 Horse Sport Young Riders' Scholarship and a Canadian Eventing Award of Excellence.

Jessica attends Christ the King Secondary School where she is an honour roll student. During breaks from her competition schedule, she enjoys listening to music and spending time with her friends.

Sandra Donnelly began riding almost as soon as she could walk. Active in the Canadian Pony Club, she achieved her 'A' Level and went on to compete in show jumping, earning the 1991 Alberta Show Jumping Association's Modified Jumper Championship title.

In 1990, Sandra had the distinction of qualifying two horses for the North American Young Riders' Championship, one each in show jumping and eventing. In 2004, she placed 25th at the CIC*** Fair Hill International riding Willow, a mare she purchased as a weanling at a PMU auction, to earn Long List status. In 2005, she was again Long Listed after enjoying top finishes with Buenos Aires and Whiz Kid at the CCI** Foxhall Cup Three Day Event. Currently, Sandra is Short Listed based on her finish in the 2006 CCI*** Fair Hill Three Day Event riding Buenos Aires, a horse she bred herself.

Sandra operates Alborak Stable where she provides lessons and training and also breeds sport horses specifically for eventing and jumping. Lesley Grant burst on to the Canadian Eventing scene in 2002 with two top horses, Snappy and Timber Spirit. With Snappy, sired by Queen's Plate winner Fiddle Dancer Boy, Lesley completed both the 2002 and 2003 editions of the CCI*** Fox Hall Cup and also the 2003 CCI*** Fair Hill International before the mare was sold.

With Timber Spirit, an English thoroughbred with impressive bloodlines, Lesley completed the CCI*** Fox Hall Cup two years in a row, the 2003 CIC*** World Cup Qualifier at Over the Walls Horse Trials and, in 2004, enjoyed top ten finishes at the CIC** Dreamcrest Horse Trials and the CIC** Red Hills Horse Trials. In 2005, they added a 20th place finish at CCI**** Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event to their impressive list of accomplishments and, the following year, completed Rolex's cross-country phase with no jumping penalties to finish as the third highest Canadian combination.

Lesley operates an eventing training business with her partner, 2004 Olympic Champion Leslie Law. She holds an honours degree in International Relations and Philosophy and a Masters degree in Human Rights from York University. She was the elected Rider Representative for the 2006 Canadian Eventing High Performance Committee and is also involved in the Athlete Development Program. 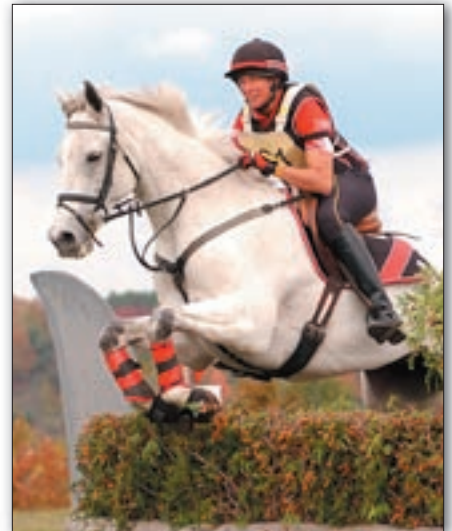

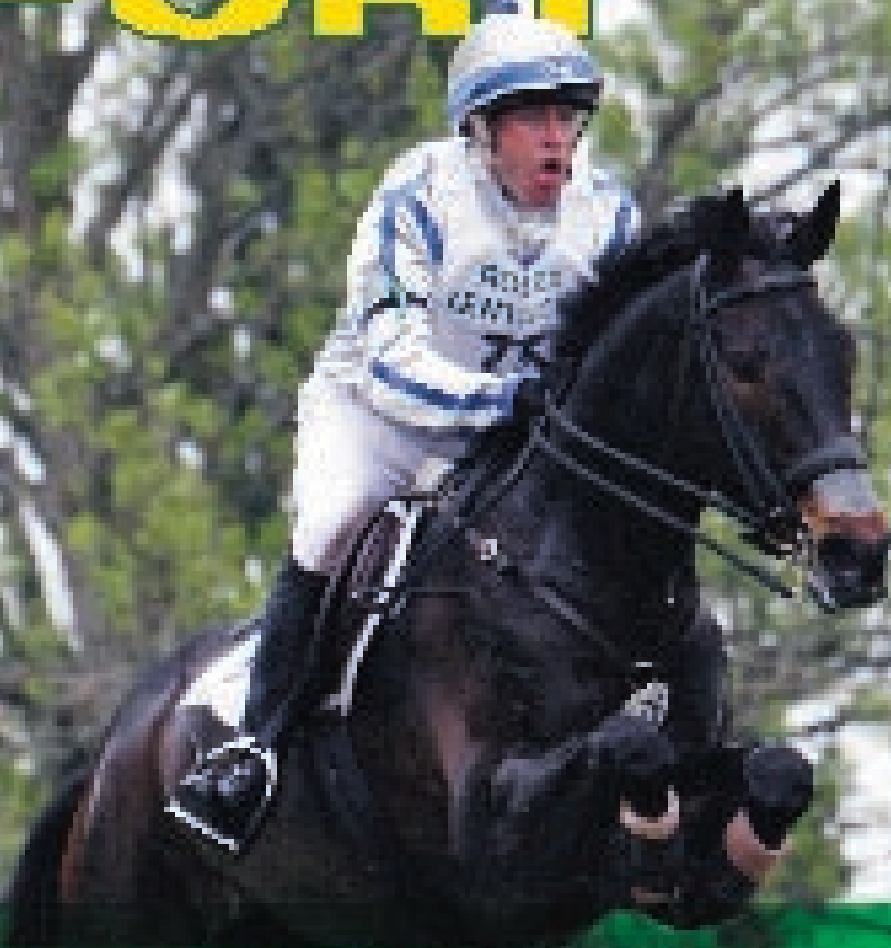
