Canadian Eventing

What is Eventing?

The sport of Eventing is best described as an equine triathlon. It began as a military exercise and competition for cavalry horses and officers to test their endurance, agility, and ability to get quickly between two points in the countryside. Today, in the modern equivalent, the sport of eventing encompasses three separate tests: dressage, cross-country, and show jumping. Each is scored individually but added together for the final results, and the winner of the competition is the competitor with the least number of penalty points gained over the three phases. The team winner is the team with the lowest aggregate number of penalties among team members.

What is Canadian Eventing?

Canadian Eventing is a committee of Equine Canada responsible for the sport of Eventing in Canada, from the domestic development to the international elite level. Canadian Eventing is governed by a committee comprised of 12 members, including two rider representatives. All activities of Canadian Eventing are administered by this committee via 5 sub-committees with the support of technical manager Fleur Tipton, who is based at the Equine Canada offices in Ottawa.

Core Objectives

Through it's Strategic Plan, the Canadian Eventing Committee is committed to programs to achieve the following Goals:

- A higher standard of performance excellence demonstrated by Canadian athletes and Canadian teams at national and international competitions and championships.
- 2. A team podium performance at the 2012 Olympic Games.
- 3. A broad and diverse foundation of athletes that enjoy and compete safely, competently and equitably

- at world class standard national and international sanctioned eventing competitions, in all provinces across Canada.
- 4. A clear development pathway for competitive athletes supported by a system of trained and certified Eventing Coaches and Officials who are committed to excellence through ongoing professional development.
- 5. A vibrant and viable economic and business model which supports the organization.

Canadian Eventing has a number of important and exciting national programs to support grass-roots, developing, high performance and elite athletes. These programs include:

- Canadian Eventing Athlete Development Scholarship Program
- National course review and standardization for competitions
- Provincial Domestic Athlete and Course Development Support Program
- Sports Science Support Program
- National Team Training Program
- Eventing NCCP Coaching Certification Program

As the voice of the Canadian Eventing National Team's listed riders, ERA maintains athlete representatives on the Equine Canada CE High Performance Committee and the Canadian Eventing Committee, the national governing body for the sport of Eventing in Canada. The CE High Performance Committee oversees all high performance activities, including planning and administering the National Team Program, hiring of the Technical Advisor, development of selection criteria and the selection process, and hiring of competition sports science support personnel. The ERA membership is also responsible for voting on the appointment of two of the Team selectors. Communication within ERA keeps riders updated with regards to policy-making and news bulletins of Canadian Eventing, Equine Canada, and the FEI. Currently, the ERA representatives on the Canadian Eventing High Performance Committee are Jennifer Holling (2006-2007) and Kelli McMullen-Temple (2007-2008).

Having tried eventing on her mom's horse, Jessica purchased Upolu from her coach, Leahona Rowland, and was competing at preliminary level by the end of the season.

In 2005, Jessica and Upolu were members of the Ontario Team that won the CCIJ* division of the North American Young Riders' Championship, also placing first individually. Jessica's success continued in 2006 when, having spent the winter in Ocala, Florida, training with U.S. Olympian Darren Chiacchia, she won the inaugural CCI** Florida International Three Day Event in April. She and Upolu then claimed Individual and Team Bronze Medals in the CCI** division of the

North American Young Riders' Championship. As a result, she was awarded a \$1,000 Horse Sport Young Riders' Scholarship and a Canadian Eventing Award of Excellence.

Jessica attends Christ the King Secondary School where she is an honour roll student. During breaks from her competition schedule, she enjoys listening to music and spending time with her friends.

In 1990, Sandra had the distinction of qualifying two horses for the North American Young Riders' Championship, one each in show jumping and eventing. In 2004, she placed 25th at the CIC*** Fair Hill International riding Willow, a mare she purchased as a weanling at a PMU auction, to earn Long List status. With Snappy, sired by Queen's Plate winner Fiddle Dancer Boy, Lesley completed both the 2002 and 2003 editions of the CCI*** Fox Hall Cup and also the 2003 CCI*** Fair Hill International before the mare was sold.

With Timber Spirit, an English thoroughbred with impressive bloodlines, Lesley completed the CCI*** Fox Hall Cup two years in a row, the 2003 CIC*** World Cup Qualifier at Over the Walls Horse Trials and, in 2004, enjoyed top ten finishes at the CIC** Dreamcrest Horse Trials and the CIC** Red Hills Horse Trials. 

Known as 'Asia' around the barn, Kerri bought Fantasia as a three-year-old from her breeder in Cape Breton, Nova Scotia. While neither of them had competed in eventing before, Kerri and Fantasia have climbed the ranks together and, in 2006, found great success at the intermediate level.

Beltane is another eastern Canadian-bred horse that Kerri is developing. Purchased from his breeder in Fredericton, New Brunswick, as a weanling, Beltane finished second in the Four-Year-Old division of the 2006 Young Event Horse Championships.

Kerri holds her Bachelor of Science in Psychology from the University of New Brunswick. A former national judo competitor who has competed at the Canada Games, Kerri holds a first-degree black belt. Her love of animals extends to dogs, and Kerri has competed her own in agility trials. In addition, she enjoys hockey, baseball and reading when time permits.

Although Wendy Southam had competed at the preliminary level with Northern Kid, nothing could prepare her for the journey of a lifetime that Ruba Z has taken her on. Imported by Augustin Walch of W. Charlot Farms, Ruba Z and Wendy became partners in 2001. Following numerous wins at the preliminary level including eight in the year 2003 alone, Wendy stepped up to intermediate in 2004, winning the CIC** division of the Dreamcrest Horse Trials in Port Perry.

Their success continued in 2005 with a second place finish at CIC** Dreamcrest followed by third place at the CCI** Virginia Horse Trials and Wendy found herself on the Canadian Eventing Team Long List. Mike Winter has been named to the Canadian Eventing Team Short or Long List every year since 1996 having competed in numerous FEI-level competitions on a variety of horses.

Riding Balista, Mike represented Canada at the 2003 Pan American Championships where he was the top placed Canadian, securing the Team Silver Medal. The following year, the pair made their Olympic debut in Athens where, again, they were Canada's top finishers. In 2005, Mike achieved a career milestone by placing in the top ten with two different horses at the CCI*** level - Kingpin was seventh at CCI*** Foxhall and, one month later, Balista was eighth in the CCI*** Jersey Fresh. Mike and Kingpin also competed at CCI*** Blair Castle in 2005 in Scotland. His success

continued in 2006 as Mike was the top Canadian rider at both CCI*** Fair Hill riding Kingpin and CCI** Virginia with Wonderful Will.

The Canadian Eventing Team is pleased to be working with David O'Connor as its International Technical Advisor.

Competing for the United States Equestrian Team, David earned three Olympic, two World Championships and two Pan American Games medals. He won the Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event three times and is a five-time winner of the Fair Hill International Three Day Event. In 1997, he became only the second American to win the renowned Badminton Three Day Event.

The pinnacle of David's eventing career was reached at the 2000 Olympic Games in Sydney, Australia, when he captured the Individual Gold Medal riding Custom Made, and also secured the Team Bronze Medal riding Giltedge.

In 2004, David officially retired from international competition to focus on the training of riders and horses. Together with his wife and Olympic medallist teammate, Karen O'Connor, they operate training facilities at their home base in Virginia as well as Florida.

David is the President of the United States Equestrian Federation and is also a member of the FEI Eventing Committee. In addition, David is the cross-country course designer for several venues including the new Ocala Horse Park in Florida and the North American Young Riders' Championship in Virginia.
