arly's involvement with horses seemed destined as her parents, Rosemary Campbell and Gary Cooper, first met at a horse show. With horses on their family farm, it wasn't long before Carly continued the family tradition. At the age of five, she began entering lead-line classes at the local fair on a cute black and white Shetland pony and has never looked back.

First qualifying to compete at Toronto's famed

Royal Horse Show in the pony divisions, Carly quickly progressed to jumpers while also contesting the hunter equitation divisions. and Climbing her way up the Carly eventually ranks. enjoyed a successful Young Riders' career with the help of two horses, Rex Get Busy and Croft Temptation, where, incredibly, she won medals at the North American Young Riders' Championship for four consecutive years.

In her North American Young Riders' Championship debut in 2000, Carly and Rex Get Busy were members of the Junior Team in Colorado, claiming both the Individual and Team Gold medals.

Riding in the Championship division in 2001, Carly earned Team Silver and Individual Bronze medals and, the following year, Ontario again captured the Team Silver while Carly placed sixth individually. In her final year of eligibility at 21 years of age and riding Croft Temptation, Carly concluded her

Young Riders' career in style, helping Ontario to win the elusive Team Gold Medal at the 2003 Championship held in Bromont, QC.

Two years in a row, 2003 and 2004, Carly and Croft Temptation topped the 2003 Jump Canada National Talent Squad Series and earned 'carded athlete' status with Sport Canada as potential future members of the Canadian Equestrian Team. They also took top honours in the Ontario Rising Star Series, an accomplishment that resulted in her


father presenting her with a brand new truck on behalf of the sponsor, Gary Cooper Chev Olds.

Coached by Canadian Olympian Beth Underhill, Carly values the support of her parents and her two brothers, Jeff and Todd. In

addition, her mother continues to compete and can often be found at the same horse shows as Carly, showing in the senior divisions.

Carly and Croft have formed a strong partnership in their many years together and, in 2003, Carly called on Croft Temptation to be her mount for the 2003 North American Young Riders' Championship. The rest is history, as Carly and Croft Temptation became members of the Gold Medal Team. At the end of the 2003 and 2004 seasons, Carly and Croft Temptation topped the Ontario Rising Star Series and also won the Eastern Division of the 2004 Jump Canada Talent Squad Series.






Napier 1995 dark bay Oldenburg gelding, 16hh by Coupon

Carly's relationship with Napier might still be in the formative stages, but the cat-like Napier has proved himself to be a worthy competitor. Found in the barns of well-known Dutch rider Eric van der Vleuten, Napier was imported to Canada in 2003. His speedy style placed Carly second in the \$25,000 Canada Post Speed Derby held at the CSI-W Bromont International in Bromont, QC, two years in a row! The Oldenburg gelding is stepping up to the Olympic level of Grand Prix, having competed in his first Grand Prix event in June of 2004.

Affectionately known as 'Lucy', Santa Lucia was discovered right here in Canada, purchased from Canadian Equestrian Team member Eric Lamaze as a seven-year-old.
