What is Jump Canada?

Jump Canada is the Committee of Equine Canada's Sport Division that represents the jumping discipline, which includes hunter, jumper, hack and hunt seat equitation. The Jump Canada Board when fully constituted is made up of fourteen voting members, a Chair, representatives of the ten Jump Canada Committees, two members-at-large and the past chair. The Jump Canada Board is accountable to Equine Canada (EC) and all members of the hunter, jumper, equitation and hack communities for operating in a fiscally responsible manner, for running national programs for its constituents, and for the accomplishment of its goals.

The Jump Canada Board works in close collaboration with the EC Manager, Karen Hendry-Ouellette who works from the Equine Canada office in Ottawa. This ensures that all responsibilities are carried out within Equine Canada rules, regulations, policies and procedures and that High Performance programs are in line with National standards as per our funding partners.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

1. To encourage rider and horse development.
2. To develop, build and grow Canada's hunter/jumper community.
3. To improve the effectiveness of communications to internal and external audiences.
4. To administer and manage the Jump Canada organization effectively and efficiently.
5. To improve and increase funding and sponsorship base.

Since its inauguration in 1998, Jump Canada has initiated important national programs, fostered grassroots development within the provinces, fielded successful teams at World Championships, Pan American Games and Olympic Games, and maintained financial responsibility.

Owners are particularly important to the success of show jumping in Canada. Through their support of the athletes and ownership of their horses, owners make it possible for Canada to field competitive teams in international events. Their support is paramount to Canada's success and, each year, Jump Canada presents the Owner of the Year Award in recognition of their invaluable contribution to the sport.

David Arcand

Born and raised in Quebec, David Arcand has spent most of his life in the saddle. First learning to ride at the age of eight, he began to take the sport more seriously by the time he was 16. At the same age, he entered and won his first grand prix competition. Three years later, at the age of 19, he turned his pastime into his career, becoming a professional show jumping athlete.

In 2013, Arcand opened his own facility, Santos Stables, located 20 minutes outside of Montreal. He currently teaches approximately a dozen students, often travelling with them to major competitions across North America, including Wellington, Florida, where he is based during the winter season.

Arcand earned impressive results in 2013, including fifth in the \$35,000 Caledon Cup Phase I and eighth in the \$35,000 Caledon Cup Phase II at the CSI2* Canadian Show Jumping Tournament in Palgrave, ON. Arcand ended the season on a high note, earning the Reserve Championship title riding Cassis Z Ten Halven in the Jump Canada National Talent Squad Series Final held at the CSI4*-W Royal Horse Show in Toronto, ON.

As the son of Canadian Olympian Jonathan Asselin and Nancy Southern, whose family owns the world-renowned show jumping venue Spruce Meadows, it is no surprise that Ben Asselin has chosen to follow in his family's footsteps. His older sister, Kelly Koss-Brix, is also an accomplished show jumping competitor.

In 2006, Asselin won the silver medal at the FEI Children's International Jumping Final for riders aged 12 to 14. As a junior, Asselin posted a perfect score of five clear rounds riding Lolita to win the Individual Gold Medal at the 2010 North American Junior Championship, also leading Alberta to Team Gold. As a result, Asselin was awarded the Gillian Wilson Trophy as Equine Canada's 'Junior Equestrian of the Year' for 2010.

In 2012, Asselin made his senior Canadian Show Jumping Team debut as a member of the Nations' Cup team in Buenos Aires, Argentina. The youngest member of the team, Asselin helped Canada tie for second place. By 2013, Nations' Cup competition had become a family affair – he rode alongside his father at the Spruce Meadows "Continental" tournament in June and with his sister at CSIO4*-W Porto Alegre, Brazil, in October. Also in 2013, Asselin scored his first victory in the International Ring at the Spruce Meadows "Masters" tournament, winning the \$205,000 Encana Cup riding Makavoy.

Yann Candele

Birthplace: Normandy, France

Birthdate: March 11, 1971

Hometown: Caledon, Ontario

Born in France, Yann Candele began riding at the age of 10 and twice competed at the European Junior Championships. Candele has since competed around the world including in Japan where he won the 1991-1992 Asian World Cup League. In 1999, Candele moved to Canada to work for Olympic Champion Eric Lamaze. Representing his native France, Candele made several Nations' Cup appearances and competed at the 2004 World Cup Final in Milan, Italy.

After obtaining his Canadian citizenship in 2008, Candele led Canada to back-to-back victories in the 2009 and 2010 Nations' Cups in Wellington, Florida, and was a member of Canada's fifth place team at the 2010 World Equestrian Games in Kentucky. Incredibly, Candele has won four consecutive Canadian Show Jumping Championship titles riding Pitareusa (2010), Game Ready (2011 and 2012), and Showgirl (2013). In the 2014 Nations' Cups in Wellington, Florida, Candele and Showgirl led Canada to victory by producing double clear rounds.

Since 2007, Candele has operated his own training business, Normandy Hills, with his wife, Jennifer Candele. The couple has three children, Alexandre (2003), Tate (2005), and Mathilde (2009). When not riding, Candele enjoys golf and cheering on his favourite hockey team, the Toronto Maple Leafs

Show jumping is a shared passion for the Chad family. Parents Rob and Laurel, both active riders, introduced their daughters, Bretton and Kara, to the sport. While encouraged to try a variety of sports and activities growing up, both young women elected to follow in their parents' footsteps.

Chad has made huge strides in the sport, quickly progressing from the pony ranks in 2008 to making her debut on the Canadian Show Jumping Team Short List in 2014. Along the way, she won numerous championship titles in the junior divisions, and first represented Canada internationally as a member of the Young Riders' Nations' Cup tour in 2011, competing in team events in Belgium and Austria. She recently competed in her second consecutive Hollow Creek Young Riders' Nations Cup in Wellington, FL.

Riding Alberto II, Chad scored her first major victory, the €23,500 1.45m Grand Prix in the CSI2* division of the 2013 Global Champions Tour event in Vienna, Austria. Chad spent the fall of 2013 competing in Europe under the tutelage of 2012 Olympic team gold medalist Ben Maher of Great Britain.

Chad balances her competitive goals with studying at Claremont McKenna College in California.

Mac Cone

Birthplace: Memphis, Tennessee

Birthdate: August 23, 1952

Hometown: King, Ontario

A steady performer at the international level for more than 30 years, Mac Cone has competed on both the U.S. and Canadian Equestrian Teams. Following early beginnings training under the legendary Bert de Nemethy, the Memphis native moved north after marrying Canadian horsewoman Brenley Carpenter in 1979.

Riding Elute, Cone was the highest-placed Canadian rider at the 1996 Atlanta Olympics. It was a feat he would repeat at the 2002 World Equestrian Games in Jerez, Spain, riding Cocu. He was a member of Canada's Silver Medal Team at the 2007 Pan American Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, riding Melinda. At the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games riding Ole, Cone made history as a member of Canada's Silver Medal Team. He has most recently ridden in Nations' Cup competition in Calgary, Alberta (2012 and 2013), Wellington, Florida (2013), and at the inaugural 2013 Furusiyya Nations' Cup Final in Barcelona, Spain, with Amor van de Rostal.

In addition to his riding skills, Cone is recognized for his coaching abilities, having trained 1986 World Champion Gail Greenough and 2003 Pan American Games competitor Mark Samuel. Cone operates Southern Ways Stable in King, ON.

Ever since her parents bought her a rocking horse for her second Christmas, Tiffany Foster's life has included horses. She began taking lessons at age eight and eventually began training with Brent and Laura Balisky in Langley, BC. Under their guidance, Foster had the distinction of winning both the Running Fox CET Medal and the Jump Canada Medal at the 2001 Royal Horse Show in Toronto.

In 2006, Foster began working for Olympic gold medalist Eric Lamaze and is now head trainer at his Torrey Pines Stables. She exploded onto the international show jumping scene in 2011 and made her Canadian Equestrian Team debut aboard Southwind VDL in the \$350,000 BMO Nations' Cup at the Spruce Meadows "Masters" tournament, helping the team earn a second place finish.





Eric Lamaze

Birthplace: Montreal, Quebec

Eric Lamaze made history by becoming the first equestrian athlete to win an Individual Olympic Gold Medal for Canada with his beloved stallion, Hickstead. The incredible accomplishment came just two days after Canada won the Team Silver Medal at the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games. By the end of the 2008 season, Lamaze was ranked the number one show jumping rider in the world, a feat he would accomplish again in 2010 and 2011.

A three-time Canadian Show Jumping Champion, Lamaze has represented Canada in five consecutive World Equestrian Games (1994, 1998, 2002, 2006 and 2010), claiming Individual Bronze in 2010 where Hickstead was also named 'Best Horse'. Considered one of the greatest show jumping horses of all time, Hickstead won numerous major grand prix titles including Calgary (2007 and 2011), Geneva (2008), Aachen (2010), La Baule (2011), and Rome (2011) before his tragic death in November of 2011. Moving forward, Lamaze was a member of Canada's fifth-placed team at the 2012 London Olympics riding Derly Chin du Muze and is now enjoying tremendous success with several new mounts, including Powerplay and Zigali P S.

An avid golfer, Lamaze divides his time between North America and Belgium.

Success continued in 2014 with Macpherson earning the reserve championship title in the highly-competitive Artisan Farms Young Rider Grand Prix Series, open to riders of any nationality aged 16 to 25, in Wellington, FL.

Macpherson is currently a fourth year student at Western University where she is majoring in psychology.

Aptly dubbed ‘Captain Canada’ by his fans, Ian Millar has ridden in more team competitions than any other Canadian rider and is an eight-time Canadian Show Jumping Champion. At the 2012 London Olympics, Millar set a world record by becoming the first athlete in any sport, from any nation, to represent their country in 10 Olympic Games. Millar achieved his best Olympic performance to date in London with a top 10 finish individually.

Millar’s Pan American Games record is also impressive. He has earned nine medals, including two individual gold and one team gold, in eight Pan Am appearances. In 1988 and 1989, Millar and his legendary partner, Big Ben, broke new ground by becoming the first-ever horse and rider combination to win back-to-back World Cup Finals.

The most decorated equestrian in Canadian history, Millar is a member of the Order of Canada and the Canadian Sports Hall of Fame, and an honorary doctorate of the University of Guelph. In 2013, he was inducted into the Ontario Sports Hall of Fame.

In 2004, Phillips moved to Strathmore, AB, where she operates Caragana Show Jumpers.
